SPECIFIC RULES

1. All games shall be decided over 18 holes and scoring will be by holes. The side winning the greater number of holes shall be the winner (Hambro scoring). Games may be halved.
2. In the event of a tied match, each Captain will nominate one existing pairing from their team to play sudden death commencing at the 1st hole, unless the captains have agreed different holes for the play-off.
3. Any match started and subsequently abandoned shall be replayed, unless a result has already been reached (i.e. one team has won more holes than are left to be played).
4. The venues for the Preliminary, First, Quarter Finals and Semi-Final rounds will be drawn on a Home and Away basis. The Semi-Finals will be on neutral courses (the venues for the semi-finalists in the top half of the Draw will be the Home course from the bottom half of the Draw and vice versa) on a date set by the Governing Body. The Final shall be played on a neutral course on a date set by the Governing Body. This may be a course previously played by the finalists and may be the second Club of a player.
5. The Home Club must contact their opponents within seven days of them advancing to the next round and offer a minimum of 3 dates, within the timescale allowed (dates during the County Championship and County Week must not be offered). When agreeing the dates, a combination containing at least one weekday and one weekend day must be offered (for the purposes of this competition a bank holiday will be deemed as a 'weekend' date). These must not all be within the same week. Failure to do so within the specified time will result in the loss of home advantage. All matches must be played by the last date of any specific round, although matches may be played before the start date if both sides are in agreement.

Preliminary Round – must be completed before end April 2018

First Round – must be completed before end May 2018

Quarter Finals – must be completed before 12th July 2018

Semi-Finals – Friday 27 July 2018

Final – Sunday 9 September 2018

The Home Captain should notify the Organiser, in advance, of the agreed dates. In the event of any problems in advance of, or on the day of, a match, please contact the Organiser.
