GENERAL COMPETITION GUIDELINES apply – See separate sheet

1. This is a League System consisting of three Divisions
2. Each Club may enter one team
3. Each Club will play the other Clubs in their Division once and will arrange its own fixtures – if possible, Clubs should offer at least one weekend and one weekday option to their opponents (for the purposes of this competition a bank holiday will be deemed as a 'weekend' date), these should not be in the same week. The Draw will be made in September to determine whether matches are played at Home or Away
4. All matches are to be completed by 31 August 2018
NB: The Organiser must be informed, in advance, of agreed dates
5. Team Captains must play their players in playing handicap order
6. Each match will consist of 5 games over 18 holes played to a conclusion (no halves).
7. In the event of course closure, necessitating the abandonment of the match, the result shall stand at the score after the front 9 in all the matches that have been completed
8. **SCORING** one point will be awarded for every game won (i.e. maximum points per match = 5)
9. Any Club not able to field a team of a minimum of 2 players on the pre-arranged date will be banned for the remainder of that year. Their points will be nullified in ALL their matches and points taken away accordingly. If a team of 2 or more players can be available on the day to play, any missing players' match points will be given to the opposition. (max 3 points)

The Weston Trophy, The Weston Plate and The Weston Bowl

The Weston Trophy will be awarded to the Club with the most matches won in Division 1
The Weston Plate will be awarded to the Club with the most matches won in Division 2
The Weston Bowl will be awarded to the Club with the most matches won in Division 3

These Trophies will be awarded to the Winners at the following AGM.

In the event of a tie in any Division, it will go back to:

1. the number of points (i.e. games won)
2. Individual scores of matches (i.e. total of holes up in all the games)
3. The winner of the match between the two tied teams.

Promotion

In Divisions 2 and 3, the Winner and Runner-up of each Division will be promoted to the higher Division for the following year.

In the event of a tie, it will go back to:

1. the number of points (i.e. games won)
2. Individual scores of matches (i.e. total of holes up in all the games)
3. The winner of the match between the two tied teams.

Relegation

In Divisions 1 and 2, the two Clubs with the least number of matches won will be relegated to the lower Division for the following year

In the event of a tie, it will go back to:

1. the lowest number of points
2. Individual scores of matches (i.e. lowest total number of holes up in all the games)
3. The winner of the match between the two tied teams.

Any new entrant will be placed in Division 3.

If a participating Club in Divisions 1 or 2 decide not to re-enter, three Clubs will be promoted from the lower Division at the end of the year to ensure that there are 6 Clubs in these Divisions.
