4. Matters Arising from Notes of meeting held on 18 October 2019:
 - Jubilee Shield – After consideration the Governing Body concluded that the format should remain as existing ie no set dates or neutral courses.
 - County 2nd Team – There was an extremely positive response to the questionnaire and the GB had given their agreement to a County 2nd Team. Unfortunately Covid-19 led to cancellation of all competitions.

5. The Main and Seniors Championships in 2021 will be split:
Stroke & Matchplay Championship will be held at Felixstowe
Seniors Stroke & Matchplay Championship will be held at Thorpeness
6. The majority of Clubs appear to be going ahead with the already scheduled dates/fixtures for 2021 friendly matches.
7. The Friendly Fixture meeting will not take place this year. Captains/Vice-captains will therefore need to liaise directly to schedule 2022 dates/fixtures.

Aldeburgh will host the 2021 fixture meeting – a date will be advised in the New Year.
