6. WHS:

Every affiliated member will have a unique handicap ID known as their Handicap Index (“HI”). Your HI is calculated from the best 8 of your last 20 qualifying competitions. The HI will be the basis for entry to competitions.

At each course you play, including your own, you decide which tees you are playing from and then look up your HI which will give you a Playing Handicap (“PH”). The PH is dependent on the slope rating for that course and tee. Even if the PH is higher than the competition maximum you will receive all the PH allocated strokes.

7. Any Other Business:

- Viv Kemp had been asked to raise the tradition of standing at the beginning of the AGM in respect for deceased members. The tradition continues but can only happen if the Clubs have notified the Secretary.
