The Team Captain is required to: -

- On the day of competition, players' handicaps must be active.
- Write out the team list ready for simultaneous exchange half-an-hour before the tee time.
- In all Divisions, the list should be in handicap index order.
- Inform players they can only take advice from their caddies, Captain of the day or referees.
- Players are allowed to acknowledge spectators and thank them for their support.

Pace of play

The Team Captain should be responsible for making sure the pace of play is reasonable. Slow play will be penalised under Rules of Golf 6-7

It is expected a two ball should take no more the 2hrs for 9 holes.

The maximum time allocated per shot is 40 seconds. 10 extra seconds are allowed for the first player to play:

- a) on a par three hole,
- b) her approach shot and
- c) a chip or putt.

The timing will start when a player has had sufficient time to reach her ball, she has had a few seconds to select her club and she is able to play without distraction. Time spent determining yardage will count as time taken for the next stroke.

On the putting green, timing will start when the player has had a reasonable amount of time to lift, clean and replace her ball, repair ball marks and move loose impediments on her line of putt. Time spent looking at the line from beyond the hole and/or behind the ball will count as part of the time taken for the next stroke.

The penalty for a breach of Rule 6-7 is loss of hole in match play.

The Course

In the event of Course closure, necessitating the abandonment of the match, the result shall stand at the score if all the games have been completed at least 9 holes.
